(TELEPHONE RINGING)

MALE IN BACKGROUND: A-1, (Overlap) World Trade.

MALE ANSWERING PHONE: Fire department.

MALE IN BACKGROUND: Bobby, it's a fire bomb.

MALE ANSWERING PHONE: (Inaudible) excuse me? Hello? Hello, Fire

Department here.

MALE CALLER: No, I've got the wrong line, we're looking for New York.

MALE ANSWERING PHONE: Okay.

MALE CALLER: Thank you. (LONG PAUSE)

(PHONE RINGING) (42:39)

PAPD OFFICER MOORE: Port Authority Police, this is Officer Moore.

FIRE DEPARTMENT CHIEF LASALLE: Yeah, this is Chief Lasalle, Fire

Department.

PAPD OFFICER MOORE: Yeah, Chief.

FIRE DEPARTMENT CHIEF LASALLE: You're looking for bottles.

PAPD OFFICER MOORE: Yes, Chief.

FIRE DEPARTMENT CHIEF LASALLE: We're going to send them MSU, which is a whole-man service unit with a chief officer. Where do you want them to hook up, at the tunnel?

PAPD OFFICER MOORE: (To personnel at the station) Yeah, we've got Chief Lasalle on the phone. He ... he's sending bottles over. Where do they want him to hook ... (To Chief Lasalle) Is this Jersey City?

That's where they've got me stationed.

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: Right.

SERGEANT: Uh, wondering, you got any TV signals at all coming out of the Trade

Center?

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: Uh, all the ... no, all the local channels are down.

SERGEANT: All local channels are down?

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: Right.

SERGEANT: Okay. Thank you. (LONG PAUSE)

SERGEANT: All right, it's (inaudible) again. We got the World ... we got the World

Trade Center in a collapse over there.

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: Right, South Tower?

SERGEANT: Yeah.

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: South Tower, Sammy?

SERGEANT: Yeah, one of the towers.

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: South Tower.

SERGEANT: South Tower.

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: Completely?

SERGEANT: Okay.

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: Completely?

SERGEANT: What? I can't hear you.

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: Completely?

SERGEANT: No, just a partial.

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: Just a partial, where? Up on the top?

SERGEANT: Hold on.

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: (To personnel at the station) It was just a partial.

MAN IN BACKGROUND: South collapsed.

SERGEANT: South Tower collapsed. Okay. All right. You got it.

(PHONE RINGING)

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: Fire Dispatch, can I help you?

SERGEANT: Hello, this is Sergeant.

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: Yes.

SERGEANT: (Inaudible) Department over here at the Port Authority.

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: Right.

SERGEANT: All right? Whatever plans you got, we can get five to ten police officers

... get from Journal Square to PATH station ...

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: Yes?

SERGEANT: When they get at the station ... all right? So we help them out with security up here?

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: Okay, what ... what did you want, I mean ...

SERGEANT: All right, so get five guys ... (To personnel at the station) Is five

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: Five cops? This is the Fire Department.

SERGEANT: How am I getting the Fire Department when I'm on one line to Jersey

City ...

FIRE DISPATCH - DAVIS: Oh, that's (OVERLAPPING CONVERSATIONS)

SERGEANT: All right. I'll find out. (01:39:24) (LONG PAUSE)

SERGEANT HOLLAND: Sergeant Holland. (PAUSE)

(PHONE RINGING)

SERGEANT HOLLAND: Sergeant Holland.

MAN: Yeah, you didn't call us?
