MALE: Get everybody out of the building.

MALE: O-S-2, seven-seven.

MALE: M-1, M-2, to Joe!

MALE: Two-six-one, Eddie?

FEMALE: B-4 to C-1.

MALE: This is Eddie, I'm on (Inaudible).

MALE: (Inaudible)

MALE: Sean go!

MALE: (Inaudible)

MALE - FRANCIS RICCIARDELLI: Nine-six, seven-seven. (4:59)

MALE:: O-S-3 to O-S-2, Vinnie? (CROWD NOISES IN BACKGROUND)

MALE: M-1, M-15, go. (CROWD NOISES IN BACKGROUND)

MALE: Go to West and Fulton. (HEAVY STATIC)

MALE: You guys down?

MALE: NO,, we didn't copy that, (Inaudible), what's going on?

MALE: Meet outside. Meet outside.

MALE: Copy. Where you want to meet, Eddie?.

MALE: On the west side.

MALE: Two-six, oh-one, (Inaudible).

MALE: Go with, uh, (Inaudible)

MALE: Two-seven, Jose, you okay?

MALE: Six-one, I'm outside the building already. Be advised that the tower ...

MALE: B-6 to E-0, Tom, come down to 310-B.

MALE: O-S-6, O-S-4, Brian.

MALE: 113-B to, uh, E-zero-N, (Inaudible) Tom?

MALE: N-zero senior, N-zero, senior officers.

MALE: Twenty-four, Pete, on my way down.

PETE: Roger that. (CANNOT ASCERTAIN IF THIS IS PETE NEGRON)

MALE: (Inaudible), M-1. (PAUSE)

MALE: B-1 ... A-1 (Inaudible) meet at the (Inaudible) console.

MALE: Nine-zero to, uh, (Inaudible).

MALE: (Inaudible), to all ACE employees. Report to 310-B lobby.

MALE: 0-F-6, 0-F-4, Brian?

MALE: Three-six to E-one, Tom?

MALE: Four-two-three (Inaudible) E-one, Tom? (PAUSE) (15:10)

MALE: Two-zero, Tommy McNally, Tommy McNally.

MALE: E-one, Tom?

MALE: Eleven-zero, senior officers. Senior officers.

MALE: Go, eleven-zero.

MALE: Do you have Tommy McNally with you?

MALE: Negative. I'm in Stairway ... I don't know what ... 23, heading down.

MALE: M-2 to M-1-3?

MALE: (Inaudible), go.

MALE: (Inaudible) the fucking stairway.

MALE: Three-nine, two-seven, Carmen.

MALE: One-fourteen-B to E-1, Tom?

MALE: (SIRENS) Three-nine, two-seven, Carmen.

MALE: O-S-6, O-S-4, Brian?

MALE: One-fourteen-B to E-one, Tom?

MALE: O-S-2, seven-seven.

MALE: Two-six to Lenny.

(SOUNDS OF TRANSMISSIONS BEING ATTEMPTED)

(VERY, VERY FAINT VOICES - UNABLE TO DISCERN WORDS)

MALE: (ECHOES) O-S-2, O-S-5, Vinnie?

VINNIE: Go, (Inaudible).

MALE: Did you guys get out of there?

VINNIE: Yeah, how about you guys? Everybody okay?

MALE: (ALARMS) I don't have all of the head count. But, uh, what I got is fine. We are in the A stair, going down.

VINNIE: We're over by the Financial Center.

MALE: (ALARMS) Roger, I'll try to meet up with you.

MALE: Vinnie, another plane just hit the other building. (PAUSE)

(CROWD NOISE)

MALE: O-S-6, O-S-4, Brian. (PAUSE)

MALE: O-S-2, O-S-5.

MALE: Go Vin.

MALE: Repeat that, what? What was (Inaudible)?

MALE: They said another plane just ... flew by and hit building two.

MALE: God!!!!

MALE: 101, B-6, Jimmy.

MALE: Go for B-6.

MALE: Jimmy, go to the 310-B console.

MALE: Get out of the console. Head out to, uh, (Inaudible) out (Inaudible) Building

Five.

MALE: Broadway and Fulton. Broadway and Fulton.

MALE: Yeah, come up Broadway.

MALE: Roger, Broadway and Fulton.

MALE: This is an emergency. Um ... on 43rd floor (Inaudible) here. Could someone

please phone for help? (PAUSE) (21:00)

MALE: (Inaudible), come over. (PAUSE)

MALE: We need medical attention. Somebody, uh ... is in bad condition here, 43rd

Floor.

MALE: All right, stand by. I'll transfer to the medical channel.

MALE: Say that again?

MALE: One-one, seven-seven, desk.

MALE: I don't have the number of the (Inaudible) now. (PAUSE)

ED CALDERONE: Seven-seven, go.

MALE: (Inaudible)

MALE: Copy. We'll go up through (Inaudible) and search. (PAUSE)

MALE: O-S-6, O-S-4, Brian?

MALE: Two-one, two-one, go to two! (PAUSE)

MALE: O-S-6, O-S-4, Brian?

MALE: (Inaudible) five-six, Alan?

MALE: Four-six, four-three. (22:40)

MALE: (Inaudible) one, Tom?

MALE: Two-seven, two-seven, Arlene.

MALE: (Inaudible)

FEMALE: (Inaudible) seventeen-C.

MALE: Arlene? (PAUSE)

MALE: Two-seven, Carmen. Two-seven, two-seven, Jose. (PAUSE) Two-seven,

Sabula.

MALE: Yeah, Sabula's with me. (Inaudible), where's everybody?

MALE: I'm with, uh ... (Inaudible) very far away from World Trade, man. (Inaudible).

MALE: Where ... where's (Inaudible)?

MALE: He's with me, but I don't know ... we're running (Inaudible) crowd ... I don't

know (Inaudible).

MALE: (Inaudible) two is outside. We're (Inaudible) at the center, Sabula and myself,

George, Rudy, and the rest of the guys.

MALE: That's a copy, thank God.

MALE: What about Louie (Inaudible) the booth.

MALE: I don't know. She was on 78, and that's why I was calling.

MALE: I know it ran from 44.

MALE: Two-six, eight-five, Sammy. (Inaudible)

MALE: (Inaudible) came out of the stairway.

MALE: Go for eight-five, Jimmy.

MALE: Jimmy, get everybody the Seaport. Let's ... let's make it the Seaport. I want to get everybody way out of this area. All right, take all your guys over to the Seaport, all right?

JIMMY: You got it, Seaport.

MALE: That's a copy, (Inaudible) that's where I'm going.

MALE: (Inaudible), you're out of the building, right?

MALE: One-four, Command B, senior (Inaudible) Tom?

MALE: (Inaudible), go!

MALE: Copy on ... we're trying to get everybody to the Seaport, all right? Me and Eddie are coming down to where the sidewalks ... trying to see if anybody is (Inaudible) there.

MALE: Okay, we are going to head to the Seaport.

MALE: Seaport.

MALE: Head to the Seaport (Inaudible)!

MALE: Two-seven (Inaudible).

MALE: (Inaudible) Jimmy.

MALE: (CROWD NOISES) Go ahead! (PAUSE) (26:18)

MALE: O-S-5, O-S-4, Tom?

MALE: M-18, Bobby.

MALE: Go, Eddie.

MALE: (Inaudible) (GARBLED/STATIC)

MALE: One-fourteen-B to Stevie Robinson

MALE: Go, one-fourteen-B.

MALE: (Inaudible)?

MALE: I'm on nineteen, I'm on my way down.

MALE: Okay.

MALE: (Inaudible) to (Inaudible), is everybody okay?

FEMALE: (ALARMS IN BACKGROUND) (Inaudible) I'm okay, but Carmen and is not, (Inaudible) together with Carmen, and I'm on 41 floor.

MALE: Hi, um, this (Inaudible) guys?

FEMALE: (Inaudible) Carmen (Inaudible).

MALE: Two-seven, Arlene?

FEMALE: (Inaudible)

MALE: Larry, is Mike with you?

MALE: (Inaudible) anybody?

MALE: Go, Eddie.

MALE: Everybody (Inaudible) coming down yet?

MALE: (Inaudible) is heading down to the second floor.

MALE: Okay, you don't have Tommy with you, do you?

MALE: Right now I don't have nobody with me. I don't have no (Inaudible)

MALE: (Inaudible) everybody outside of there.

MALE: (Inaudible) with me, Ed.

MALE: I'm up towards Broadway.

MALE: (Inaudible)

MALE: M-(Inaudible) and M-11 is out of the building.

MALE: Two-seven, two-seven, Major.

FEMALE: (Inaudible)

MALE: Arlene.

MALE: Two-seven (Inaudible).

FEMALE: (Inaudible)

MALE: Two-seven, are you guys okay?

FEMALE: (Inaudible) I'm on the 28th floor coming down.

MALE: Copy that.

MALE: (Inaudible) Mike (Inaudible).

MALE: Just keep calm, uh, Arlene. Think of Jesus. Come ... come down calmly.

MALE: (STATIC/CUTTING OUT) (Inaudible) either Eddie or Ed.

EDDIE: Go for Eddie.

MALE: Do you have Larry and Mike with you?

MALE: (Inaudible) Joe, go to six.

MALE: (Inaudible) six to one-one, Joe? (PAUSE)

MALE: Two-seven, Cruise.

CRUISE: Go for Cruise.

MALE: (Inaudible)

CRUISE: I'm in Pine Street, on William, on our way down to Seaport.

MALE: Roger. (PAUSE)

JOE: (Inaudible) one to 2-2 Dave. (ALARMS)

DAVE: Go ahead, Joe. (ALARMS)

MALE: Joe, go for Dave.

JOE: Dave, what's your location?

DAVE: Joe, we're in the lobby of, uh, Two World Trade. (PAUSE)

MALE: (Inaudible) seven-seven, Eddie, are elevators running in A Tower from 44

down?

MALE: That's a negative.

MALE: (Inaudible), Ed or Frank. (PAUSE) (29:56) Two-seven, Ed or Frank.

MAEL: Two-two, one-one, Joe.

JOE: Go ahead, go for one-one.

MALE: Joe, what's your location?

JOE: I'm on Church and Liberty.

DAVE: Copy that.

JOE - 11: Dave, what you need, Dave?

DAVE: I'm in the lobby of two, Joe. (ALARMS)

JOE: Okay, copy that. That's where I'm looking to get to. (PAUSE) (30:33)

MALE: Two-one-six, 114b (Inaudible).

JOE: (Inaudible) go.

MALE: Any word on Tom?

JOE: That's a negative. I keep calling, and I don't get any response.

MALE: All right, Joe, I'm going to be in like the Broadway/Fulton area. I'm going to see (Inaudible) and try to get heads (Inaudible) over by the Seaport, okay?

JOE: Roger.

MALE: Two-seven, two-seven, Mark?

MARK: Go ahead.

MALE: (Inaudible), okay?

MARK: Yeah, maybe we can hook up someone over by the (Inaudible). Where are you guys at now?

MALE: Mark, I'm on the corner of, uh, Reade and Church Street.

JOHN: (Inaudible) Hank.

MALE: Hey, John.

JOHN: We're getting (Inaudible) trying to reach you.

MALE: Copy (Inaudible)

MALE: (Inaudible) at this time, thank you.

MALE: (Inaudible)

MALE: O-S-6, O-S-4, Brian? (31:30)

FRANCIS RICCIARDELLI Nine-six seven-seven? (ALARMS)

MALE: Brian, nine-four. (PAUSE)

FRANCIS RICCIARDELLI: Nine-six, seven-seven? (31:45)

MALE: (Inaudible), this is nine-six.

MALE: Nine-six, seven-seven. (PAUSE)

FRANCIS RICCIARDELLI Nine-six, seven-seven. (ECHOES)

ED CALDERONE: Go, nine-six.

FRANCIS RICCIARDELLI: (Inaudible) we should try to turn off the emergency (Inaudible), people are in here crying for help. (ECHOES)

MALE: Copy that.

FRANCIS RICCIARDELLI: Maybe we can turn off that alarm, people are in there crying for help, everybody is like stuck.

MALE: Copy, what alarm is that?

FRANCIS RICCIARDELLI: The fire alarm!

MALE: Copy. (PAUSE)

MALE: Two-sixteen, (Inaudible). (SIRENS)

FRANCIS RICCIARDELLI: Copy, they haven't been getting out at all! (ECHOES)
We've got people trapped above the eighty-ninth floor, we're trying to (Inaudible) right

now. (PAUSE) (32:28)

MALE: Six-seven (Inaudible) (GARBLED/STATIC) (PAUSE)

BRIAN: Six-seven, Hank

HANK: Go ahead.

BRIAN: (Inaudible) and Church, right?

HANK: Brian, (Inaudible) Church?

BRIAN: (Inaudible) (GARBLED/ AUDIO IN AND OUT) Chambers Street.

HANK: Where are you at, Brian?

BRIAN: (Inaudible) by Chambers Street.

HANK: Copy that. (PAUSE)

MALE: O-S-5, O-S-4, Tom?

MALE: Two-seven to two-seven, Arlene and (Inaudible).

ARLENE: This is Arlene, I'm right here.

MALE: Is Otto (Inaudible) all right?

ARLENE: I think so, he was in the other building.

MALE: Location, Arlene.

ARLENE: Twenty-one, I'm still coming down.

MALE: Copy. (PAUSE) Two-seven, Arlene, how about Carmen?

ARLENE: She was still inside (Inaudible) when people started to exit the building.

MALE: Copy. (PAUSE)

JIMMY: Two-six to (Inaudible) zero, Pete.

PETE – : Go, Jimmy, go.

JIMMY: (Inaudible) to six?

MALE: Two-eight, two-seven, Carmen?

FEMALE: They don't have a radio.

MALE: Is she all right?

FEMALE: She's on Liberty right now.

MALE: Hey, you know anything about 58, if the people are all right?

FEMALE: No.

MALE: (Inaudible) (PAUSE) (35:24)

MALE: Two-six, two-zero, Hank.

MARK: Go for Mark. (Inaudible)

GENE RAGGIO: S-4 to two-six, Mark?

MARK: Go for Mark.

GENE RAGGIO: Mark, can you come to A Tower Fire Command desk? Are you

available? (LOUD NOISE/ALARMS IN BACKGROUND)

MARK: A Tower Fire Command?

MALE: Roger, A Tower Fire Command.

MARK: Copy. Will I be able to get into building two?

MALE: Where are you at?

MARK: I'm going to walk ... I'm by, uh, by Borders. I'm coming around, all the way

around Vesey Street, okay?

MALE: Roger. (PAUSE) (35:54)

MALE: (Inaudible) to John. (PAUSE)

(SHOUTS OF "GO!" AND SCREAMS CAN BE HEARD IN BACKGROUND)

MALE: (Inaudible) six to anyone.

MALE: (Inaudible) Jimmy.

JIMMY: Go for Jimmy. (PAUSE)

MALE: Eight-zero, go, Jimmy.

JIMMY: I'm fine, Pete, I'm (Inaudible) again.

MALE: Eight-zero, Tommy McNally, Tommy McNally, come in. (PAUSE) Tommy

McNally, Tommy McNally, come in. (PAUSE) (37:16)

FEMALE - JERRY: Two-thirty, three-seven, Carmen?

CARMEN: Go for Carmen.

FEMALE - JERRY: Are you guys all right? Where are you?

CARMEN: I'm in Level two, coming down now. (CRYING)

FEMALE - JERRY: Roger. Two-thirtytwo-six, Mark.

MARK: Go ahead, Jerry.

FEMALE - JERRY: How are you?

MARK: I'm fine, Jerry, how are you guys?

FEMALE - JERRY: We're all right, we're all meeting over by the cube on Broadway

for now. But if it looks dangerous, we are going to move down towards the (Inaudible)

Pace Plaza..

MARK: All right, copy. EMS wants me to respond to A Tower, (Inaudible), okay?

GENE: F-4 to (Inaudible), John White. (PAUSE)

JOHN: (Inaudible), Gene.

GENE: John, where are you at? Where's Ed Calderon?

JOHN: He's right ... he's right here, Gene, he's on the phone.

GENE: Where are lo- ... where's your ... what's your location right now?

JOHN: We're here by the OCC.

GENE: (Inaudible) the OCC ... (Inaudible) the OCC desk?

JOHN: That's affirmative, Gene.

GENE: Roger, thanks, John. Uh, I'll give you a call. Stand by a second, I'll call Ed.
